

Fiscal Year 2027 Community Project Funding

Community Project Funding (CPF) allows Members of Congress to directly advocate for how funding will be directed to specific state or local governments or eligible non-profit recipients through the <u>annual Appropriations process</u>. CPF submissions from fiscal years (FY) 2022-2024 have been authorized. Congress continues to debate the FY 2026 spending bills and those authorizations are contingent on passage.

Rep. Pettersen would like to solicit your shovel-ready projects ahead of the House Appropriations Committee's FY 2027 deadlines. Eligibility and deadline guidance have not been released by the House Appropriations Committee for the FY 2027 process, but we will share information as soon as guidance is made available. In prior years, Members of Congress were permitted to submit up to fifteen CPFs. Each project is then competitively evaluated by the House Appropriations Committee to ensure it meets eligibility requirements. All of Rep. Pettersen's selections were deemed eligible in FY 2024, FY 2025 and FY 2026.

In 2025, the House Appropriations Committee gave Members less than two weeks to seek and submit eligible projects. If the CPF process is continued this year, there is a potential for another quick turnaround, and Rep. Pettersen would like to ensure stakeholders seeking CPF funding are as prepared as possible ahead of the submission deadline.
